Fundraising

Presidential Fitness Awards

Coach Mecke is requesting that the PTO sponsor the Presidential Fitness Awards for 1st-5th grade. He is going to rename them the Hickory Creek Gold and Silver Awards. It will include challenges like pull ups, push ups, mile run, and more. He has made some changes to the rules so that all can feel included. As of right now the pricing he has for the certificates is .50 a certificate. It came to \$759 for 500 silver and 500 gold certificates. There will also be small button pins to hand out for individual success on each challenge. The cost for those is \$278.75 for 700 pins. Certificates would be award for how people do on all 5 challenges. The Awards program can take place whenever we approve. Most likely in the Spring sometime.
